And the peace of God which surpasses all understanding, shall keep your hearts, your minds through Christ Jesus. - Philippians 4:7

One of my favorite hymns of all time is "It is Well". This Sunday, August 1st we will be featuring a hymn sing of some of our most favorite songs. Sometimes the story behind the song can add great meaning to it. Here is the story behind the song, "It is Well".

Horatio G. Spafford was a successful lawyer and businessman in Chicago with a lovely family - a wife, Anna, and five children. He experienced great tragedy in his life with the death of their son with pneumonia and loss of their business to the great Chicago fire in the same year. Two years later Anna and the four daughters were headed to Europe on a French ocean liner. Mr. Spafford had planned to meet them a few days later. About four days into the crossing of the Atlantic, the French ship collided with a powerful, iron-hulled Scottish ship, the Loch Earn. The ship went down with all 226 passengers.

Later, a sailor, rowing a small boat over the spot where the ship went down, spotted a woman floating on a piece of the wreckage. It was Anna, still alive. He pulled her into the boat and led her to safety. From there she wired her husband a message which began, "Saved alone, what shall I do?" She would tell others: "God gave me four daughters. Now they have been taken from me. Someday I will understand why." Mr. Spafford booked passage on the next available ship and left to join his grieving wife. With the ship about four days out, the captain called Spafford to his cabin and told him they were over the place where his children went down. It is here that Spafford wrote the powerful words to: "It is Well With My Soul".




Monday – Friday Pick-up from 11:30 – 12:30 pm
