Light-years...

Many early-mornings I am outside with the dogs, and lately I have been looking at the constellation Orion. If you are not familiar with this constellation, it is in the southern sky and can be seen from late at night until early in the morning. Three of the most prominent stars in Orion make-up what is referred to as Orion's Belt. The 3 stars are 826, 919, and 1360 light-years away respectively. For those who aren't familiar with the term "Light-year", it is a measurement of distance...not time. A light-year is how far light travels in one year. Light travels at the rate of 186,282 miles per second. That equates to approximately 6 trillion miles in a year. Our own sun, is far enough (or close enough, depending on how you want to look at it) that it takes about 8.3 minutes for the light of the sun to reach the earth.

If we think about what this distance means... it takes 1360 years for the light from one of those stars to reach the earth. In fact, there are some stars that are over 2000 light-years away. The light from those stars that we are just now seeing was generated at the time of Jesus's birth.

What this also means is that if one of the stars in Orion's Belt "burns out", we will continue to see the light from that star for almost 1000 years, as the light that was generated will still be heading our way. Each one of the stars in the sky range in size, distance, and color. Many of them are many times larger, brighter, and hotter than our own sun. But they are so much further away that we only see them as tiny specks of light in the sky.

You could compare the light of Jesus to a star. Jesus' light began when he was born on Christmas Day and, even though he is no longer physically with us, his light has continued to shine for the last 2000+ years.

I believe that each of us, in our own way wants to be a star. We want our family and friends to remember us and think fondly of the impact that we have had on their lives, not only while we are with them today, but many years after we are gone. And, just like the millions of stars that it takes to make the beautiful night sky...it takes many different stars among us to make a beautiful human race. Each of us brings our own talents, skills, and gifts to not only our own families, but also to our church, community, and beyond.

As this is my last Circuit Rider article, I would like to say that I have been honored to serve as your Council President these past 3 years. And even though, I am not really "gone", I hope that as the years pass, I will be remembered as having a positive impact. I would also like to say "Thank-You" to the many people who have given me their support and words of encouragement over these years. To say that it has been a challenging time, is an understatement. Your support and kindness has not gone un-noticed.
