

From our Council President

We are happy to announce that we have established a Staff Parish Team to help serve the Human Resource component of our church. This team will have 5-6 members. They were selected through recommendations from the Pastor and current Church Council and will serve for a period of at least 1 year with a staggered rotation of elections.

The purpose of the Staff Parish Team is to seek to support and maintain a healthy relationship between the entire staff including the Pastor, Administrative Assistant, Music Director, Education/Small Groups Director, Nursery Attendant, and the congregation. Their duties will not, however, include the custodial support provided to the church. That support is managed through a sub-contracted company which is supervised by the Pastor and the current Property Board.

The Staff Parish Team may both advise and support the staff through any of the following areas. Share ideas, dreams, hopes, expectations and concerns of the congregation with the Pastor. Assist in establishing caring and constructive communication in an atmosphere of confidentiality and trust. Provide a safe space where conflict can be dealt with in a healthy and creative fashion. Encourage professional growth and development among the staff as well as mutual ministry between the staff and the congregation. Assist with all hire/fire procedures with staff to make sure the process is smooth and with both compassion and respect. Evaluate all staff twice a year to assure that expectations and covenants are being fulfilled.

The current members of the Staff Parish team are Cindy Westfall, Sandy Nissen, Gwen Bosaw, Deb Spears and Sean Smith. Feel free to reach out to any of the team with any questions you may have.




