### **Reflection and Celebration**

As I come to the end of my first full time year of ministry at Friedens United Church of Christ, I wanted to take a moment to reflect on our year together! It has been a full year of grieving the loss of church members and their families, of transitions with staff, and changes in church leadership structure. We celebrated together with our Installation Service and a series of sermons on what it means to be a fruitful congregation! Thanks to the patience of some talented church members, I learned the techniques to cut pie and grill brats during our annual Sausage Supper event. We help organize an All-Saints community-wide service as we mourned those in the Troy community who had lost loved ones in the last two years from Covid 19 and other circumstances. After a wonderful evening of painting creches with family and friends, we later incorporated them into a special Hanging of the Greens Service to begin the Advent Season. In early December we invited people back for our Homecoming Sunday as well as to a family-oriented Santa Fest event with food and pets and Santa Claus. We finished the year with great participation by our church families in lighting candles for the Advent wreath and some wonderful Christmas music for Christmas Eve Service. In early 2022, our church participated in a series of Lenten Services with other UCC churches in the area. I invited the congregation to a time of sharing in two Front Porch Sessions as well. During Holy Week, we held a number of special services as we walked the Journey of Jesus' last days on earth. Easter Sunday, we celebrated a Sunrise service in the Cemetery and then came back to delicious food and a special morning worship with our Confirmand and the joy of the empty tomb! In May, we celebrated the ministry of Stephanie Williams with singing by the children, a sharing of special memories and pictures. In June, we began worshipping on Sundays in Tri-Township Park while the construction in the sanctuary commenced. (Deep breath 😌 !)

For me personally, this has been a year of much joy and excitement. I have enjoyed the opportunity to walk with this church family through the ebbs and flows of life. I know when I arrived that there were several things to address. But Danielle and I have so appreciated your kind words and actions of support of us in this time of transition. I really believe that we, as a church, are on the precipice of growth and a deepening of our faith formation. As we all go back into the church this fall, there will be new sights and sounds that greet us but I believe that there is a new spirit here as well! Thank you for your faith and trust in me and my ministry! I don't take this lightly! I hope you continue to pray for me, for Danielle, and for all our leadership as we seek to follow Christ together! I can't wait to see what God has in store for Friedens UCC in the future! Your partner in Ministry!


# Meeting Minutes from Faith Formation on July 19, 2022 meeting:

### Greetings all,

Many of you have been asking about Tetyana (Tania) and what she has been up-to in the past several years. After arriving back in Ukraine from the U.S., Tania attended the National Linguistics University in Kyiv, studying primarily Chinese (and some other languages). In her junior year, she was awarded admission to the Confucius Institute in China, but was unable to attend in-person because of the Covid-19 pandemic. Despite the current war between Russia and Ukraine. Tetvana graduated from the university this past spring. She was then awarded a full scholarship to continue her studies in Taiwan. She left Ukraine about a month ago to go to Taiwan by-way-of Poland. However, before she could leave Poland, Taiwan restricted travel to their country because of Covid. She is currently in a hotel in Poland awaiting for tickets and

permission to go to Taiwan, which should happen before the end of July. Tania's mother was also able to leave Ukraine, where she was a school administrator in their village (about the size of Marine). Just for your reference, a school administrator in Ukraine earns the equivalent of \$7000 - \$9000 per YEAR. Her mother has since gone to Slovakia, where she is working in what was described as a "labor job". They left their apartment in Ukraine, but do not know if it is, or will be there when they have the chance to return. Tania's grandparents also live in their village but contact with them is sparse and spotty.

We keep in contact with Tetyana as much as we can. We have sent her the money that was donated by some of our members and a few others. She has expressed her deepest thanks for helping her out. The hotel in Warsaw was only supposed to be for a couple of days, but it has now turned into a month. That cost, as well as food, etc. has eaten away at any money that she had saved.

Tania always tells us to say "Hello" to everyone at the church as she has fond memories of attending while she was here. Please keep her, her family, and the people of Ukraine in your prayers.


