

<u>Stewardship & Finance</u>: These are ways that you can contribute to the church in the future without a lot of out-of-pocket expenses right now. This information is being shared with the congregation as part of our ongoing stewardship efforts:



#### Three Ways to Give Outside a Will

Though an updated will is a key to estate planning, don't forget about these three assets whose distributions are not controlled by a will.

**Life Insurance.** When you complete the paperwork for a life insurance policy, you choose the beneficiary of that policy. The proceeds from your policy will be paid to the beneficiary recorded on your forms, regardless of the conditions listed in your will. After you have provided for your heirs, this could be an option to consider adding Friedens UCC as a beneficiary to receive all or a percentage of these funds.

**Living trusts.** Another popular way to distribute assets is with a revocable living trust. By naming yourself as the initial trustee of your living trust and then naming a successor trustee to manage the trust if you become unable to do so, your assets are managed during your lifetime and then distributed to your beneficiaries, avoiding probate. It is "revocable" because you retain the right to change the terms of the trust.

**Retirement plans.** Here again, the beneficiaries you list in the original or modified documents will receive any assets from your retirement plans, such as a 401(k) or an IRA. If there are changes in your family or financial situation, it is essential that you review beneficiary designations as well as the other details in your estate plans. And since retirement plan assets can be heavily taxed if left to heirs, you may want to consider leaving all or a portion of these funds to Friedens UCC while leaving other assets to loved ones.

Adding Friedens UCC as a secondary or contingent beneficiary is a convenient method to continue your impact without going through the probate process. If you have any questions about any of these options as a way to support Friedens UCC, feel free to contact the church office at (618) 667-6535.

If you decide to include Friedens UCC in your future plans, please know that any gift large or small makes a difference in our ministry and we are grateful. You may want to share the following bequest language with an attorney:
