



From our Council President

Friedens has been a strong supporter of Marion Medical Mission in the past, and we will continue to have this as a mission of the month in the future. Your generous giving has resulted in the purchase of the supplies and equipment necessary to provide clean, life-saving water to the people of Africa. Here is an excerpt from the Marion Medical Mission Facebook page which explains how the planning of a well is done.

"Every year in June, the village communities come together with MMM Coordinators and Field Officers to decide where the wells will be built in the Fall. Time and time again the village communities express their gratitude for a system that is fair and transparent. Villagers tell of the wells they have built over the years, and the functionality and maintenance of those wells. They explain where more wells are needed. Then, together with the Field Officers, the villages are selected that will get wells this year. The Africans decide who gets the wells and where they are built. They organize the village communities, build the wells, maintain the wells, make the Mark V galvanized steels pumps and the PVC Roush foot-valves and plungers. Unfortunately, the need far surpasses what can be provided.

In 2021 a Field Officer in Karonga explained that on June 3, 2021, they received requests to build wells from 900 villages. At the meeting 290 villages were selected. On the 1st of September construction started, and on November 10, 2021, they finished construction on the 290 wells promised, and completed an additional 44 wells bringing the total to 334. These wells mean their children will no longer die from contaminated water, and the people will be healthier and able to work longer in their fields, producing more food, and resulting in less starvation"

Thanks again for your continued support of Marion Medical Mission. You are truly making a difference in the lives of many people.


