Technology

In these times technology is essential in the church life as it is in our everyday life. It's impact during COVID was very important and kept the congregation connected and able to continue our worship services. But as with anything involving technology, there are glitches and problems. Lately we've had problems with streaming our services on Sunday morning. This is a service provider and/or network issue. Until it is resolved, please know that the service is always recorded and will be posted on Facebook and YouTube later. Thanks for your understanding and patience. A new change in our office is the switch to a VOIP phone system. This system has many advantages such as forwarding calls to another phone, the ability to see missed calls, and the call recipient getting an email of each voicemail they receive. Another feature is the auto-attendant, where the caller listens to a message and presses a number to talk to someone on the other end. I know that most of us do not want to "talk to a machine", but this system is efficient and helpful for staff. We hope you understand the convenience this system has provided to Friedens.


